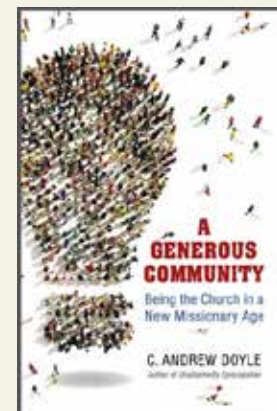
### *One Church, One Book*
