Heavy duty large trash bags	Dishwashing liquid (20 to 25 oz)
Scrub brushes (the old fashioned kind)	Laundry detergent (50 oz)
Toilet brushes with caddy (Lysol "add on" item on Amazon is a good one)	Toothpaste (6 to 8 oz sizes)
Disposable bed liners (for young children who have occasional "accidents" at night)	Toothbrushes
New towels and wash cloths	Shampoo (20-30 oz sizes)
New sheets - twin and double	Deodorant
New lightweight blankets	Plastic razors
5.5 to 7 oz size boxes of macaroni and cheese (available on Amazon)	Shaving cream
Bleach (64 oz is best)	New clothes for infants & toddlers (age 2 & under)
